A. <u>Call to Order</u>

Chairman Rodbell called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m.

B. Review, Discussion and Possible Action on AZPOST Financial Status and Future Funding Plan for Basic Training Academies for FY 2019

Due to the decline in revenue over the past ten years, the AZPOST Board felt it would be beneficial to appoint a subcommittee to review the budget situation in-depth and make recommendations to the Board on how to move forward. Some discussion points raised during the meeting were:

- Request to review Program Budget for POST.
- Core functions of POST.

- Total costs for all core functions.
- Need to standardize academy grants.
- List of all academies and current grants/agreements.
- Expiration date of each grant.
- Recruits graduating per academy.
- Cost to train a recruit, including salary.
- Cost borne by agency and cost borne by POST.

The Subcommittee felt once they were able to review some of the documents discussed, it would paint a better picture for them to make recommendations to the Board.
